Cutting Fabric

Peach - (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square

White (2) $1" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$

(2) $1" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$

First Red (2) $1" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$

(2) $1" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$

Green or Black (2) $1" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$

(2) $1" \times 5\frac{1}{2}"$

Second Red (2) $1" \times 5\frac{1}{2}"$

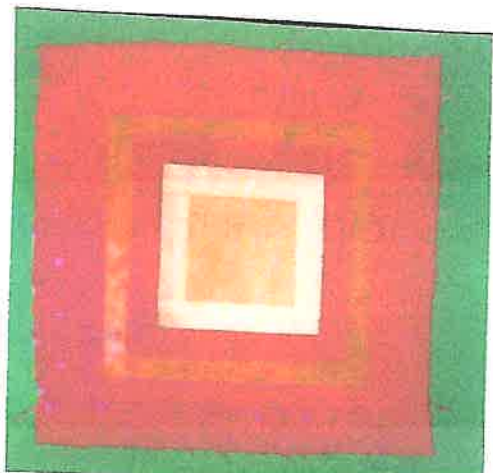
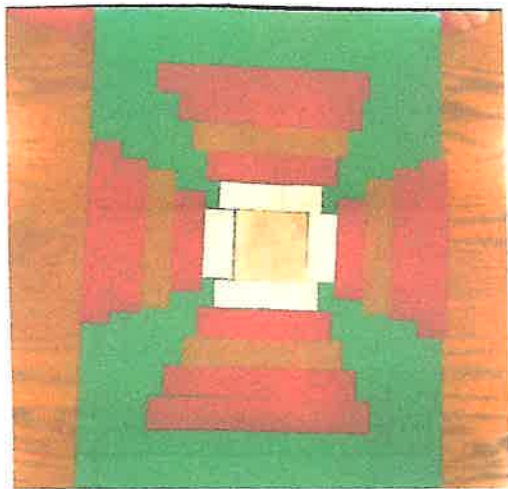
(2) $1" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$

Third Red (2) $1" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$

(2) $1" \times 7\frac{1}{2}"$

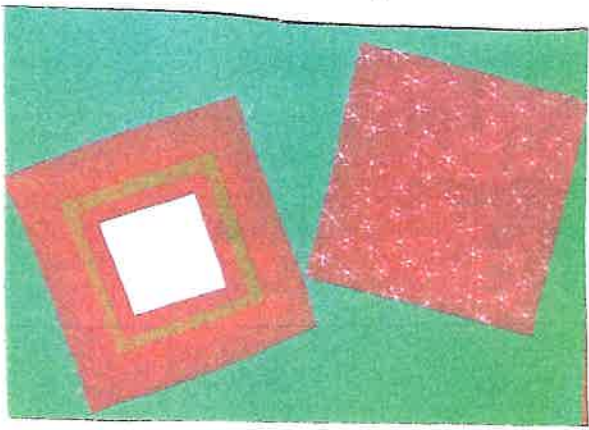
Santa's Hat - $7\frac{1}{2}$ " square

Backing and Batting (2) $7\frac{1}{2}$ " square each



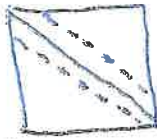
You will sew the colors ~
sewing sides first, then
top and bottom.

Your finished square should
measure $7\frac{1}{2}"$.
I am sorry that the colors
didn't print well.



Now, take your log cabin piece^{and} your Santa-hat $7\frac{1}{2}$ " square — put them right sides together.

Draw a diagonal line on the back of the "hat" fabric and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the drawn line as shown.



Cut on solid line, press open, you will have 2 like pieces, as pictured at the right.



You will now stack pieces as follows:

- batting
- Santa, right side up
- backing, right side down on Santa

Sew around the edge, leaving a 3" opening on one side.

Turn right sides out, stitch the opening closed. Top stitch around the sides
