

# A Christmas Night

## Materials:

1/4 yd. dark fabric

1/4 yd. medium fabric

1/4 yd. light fabric

1/4 yds light fabric for star background

1/2 yd. gold/yellow for stars

2/3 yd. outside border and binding

## Cutting:

- Cut (3) 2" strips of each (dark, medium and light fabrics)

## Background fabric:

- Cut (16) 2 1/4" squares
- Cut (32) 2" squares

## Gold/yellow

- Cut (4) 1 1/4" WOF (width of fabric) for border 1
- Cut (16) 2 1/4" squares
- Cut (8) 2" squares

## Outside Border

- Cut (4) 2 1/4" WOF for border
- Cut (4) 2 1/2 WOF for binding

## Sewing:

- Sew a light, medium and dark 2" strip together (as shown).




- Sew the strips in alternate directions
- Then cut into (32) 5" segments
- Set aside

## Star blocks:

- Draw a diagonal line on the back of the (16) 2 1/2" background squares . Place these right sides together with the gold 2 1/2" squares . Sew 1/4" from the drawn line (on both sides)
- Cut on the drawn diagonal line. You will now have (32) half-square triangles. Square to 2 1/2"

Arrange the 2" background squares, 2" gold square and the (4) half-square triangles as follows.  
Make 8 stars.



Check out the picture below: Arrange the blocks as in the picture. When the middle section is sewn, you will add the borders

- first the gold border and then the outside border
