## Christmas Stocking

## Material List:

1/3 yd. Fabric for stocking 1/3 yd. Fabric for lining 1/3 yd. of thin batting  $\frac{1}{4}$  yd. fabric for top band



## Sew Directions:

- 1. Lay down 2 pieces of stocking fabric RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER.
- 2. On top of the stocking fabric, place one layer of thin batting.
- 3. On top of the batting, place 2 pieces of Lining Fabric.
- 4. The last layer is 1 thin batting.
- 5. Place the pattern on top of the layered fabrics. Pin carefully and then cut out the stocking.
- 6. Sew through all layers (1/4" seam) starting at top, down the stocking and back up the other side.

## Magic Stocking:

- 7. Reach in between the two lining layers and pull the stocking right side out.
- Next, reach in between the two stocking fabrics layers and pull right side out. How about that stocking !!!
- 9. Cut a  $9 \times 15$  " rectangle for the cuff and set aside.

10. Cut a 1-3/4"  $\times$  7" rectangle. This is going to be the hanging hook. Put right sides together and sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam lengthwise. Turn right side out and press.

11. Now back to the cuff. Cut a 4-1/2" X 15 piece of thin batting. Pin that to the bottom half of your cuff fabric. Sew

the ends together to make a circle.

12. Pin the hanging hook in place. Next, pin the cuff piece (half WITH the batting) right sides together to the top of the stocking. Sew together, press up.

13. Turn the raw edge under (about  $\frac{1}{4}$ ") and press. Fold cuff

piece over to the inside of the stocking and stitch.

Stocking Top
Please add seam allowances to the sides, not to the top.
