

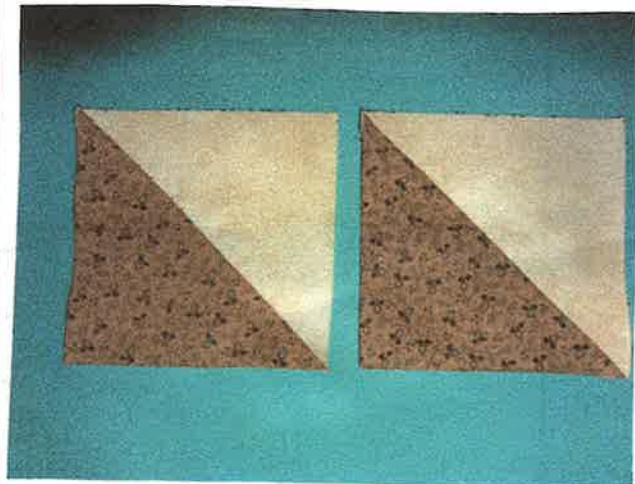
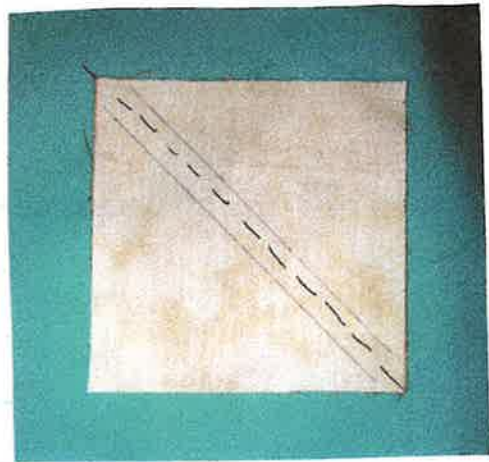
Disappearing Half Square Triangle

These directions are for two blocks

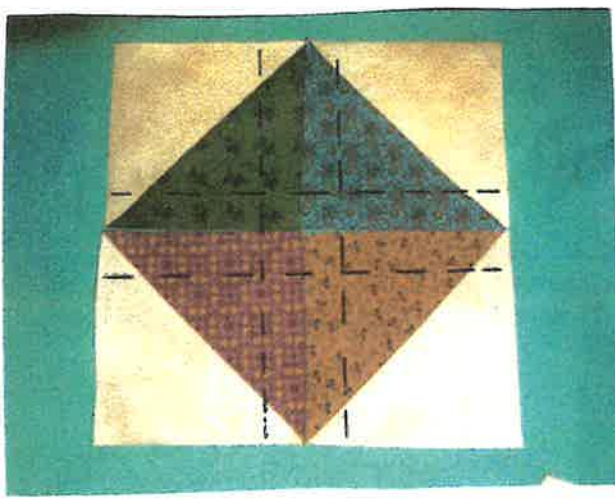


You will need (4)
5" light squares and
(4) 5" print squares.

Place a light and print square right sides together. Draw sew lines on the back of the light (as pictured). Sew on the lines and cut on the dotted line.

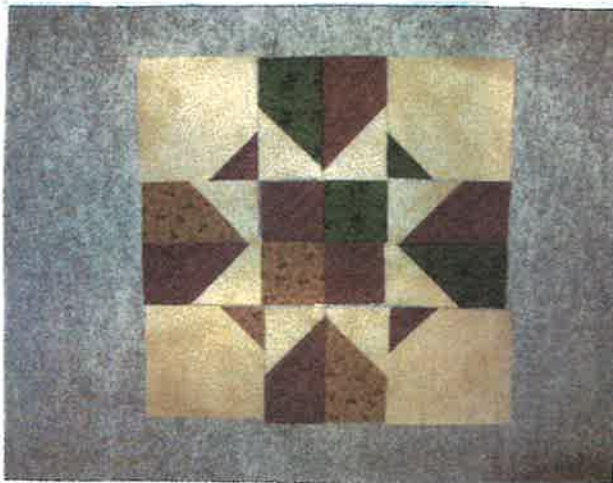
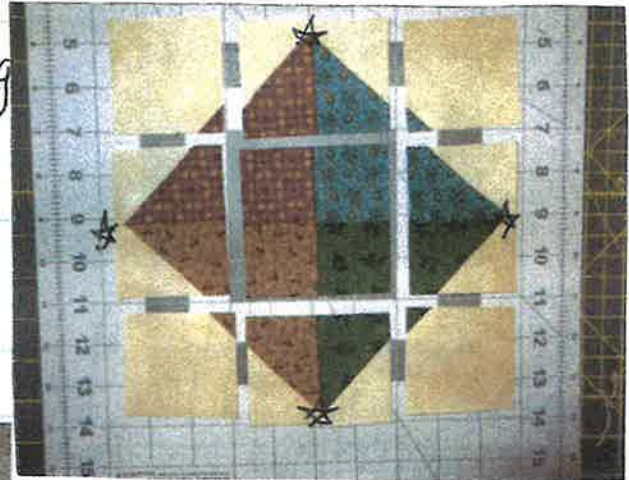


You will end up with
(2) Half square triangles
for each set. There
will be (8) in all



Sew (4) together as pictured, with the prints together in the center and the light fabrics on the outside.
Now, measure $\frac{1}{2}$ " from center and cut, as the dotted lines show.

Now, comes the disappearing part ~ turn all starred segments 180° so the point is facing the center.



When the blocks get turned, your block will look like the picture. Sew the pieces together. This block should measure $7\frac{1}{2}$ square.

Putting (4) of the blocks together will give a larger block that looks like the one pictured.
Pretty cool, don't you think?
