# O Christmas Tree

## MATERIALS

- 1 fat quarter\* blue print for background
- <sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub> yard green stripe for 1 tree and binding
- 3 (6") squares assorted pink prints for trees
- 2 (6") squares assorted purple prints for trees
- 2 (6") squares assorted green prints for trees
- 1 (6") square yellow solid for stars
- 1 (4") square brown solid for tree trunks

Paper-backed fusible web

- 1 fat quarter\* backing fabric
- 18" square quilt batting
- \*fat quarter =  $18" \times 20"$

**NOTE:** Fabrics in the quilt shown are from the Caterwauling Tales collection by Sue Marsh for RJR Fabrics.

#### Cutting

Measurements include '4" seam allowances. Patterns for appliqué are on page 20. Follow manufacturer's instructions for using fusible web. For step-by-step photos and a video, see *Sew Easy: Fusible Web Appliqué* at <u>www.fonsandporter.com/</u> <u>fusiblewebapp</u>.

#### From blue print, cut:

- 1 (16<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"-diameter) circle. NOTE: See Sew Easy: Cutting Large Circles on page 22.
- From green stripe, cut:
- 64" of 2¼"-wide bias strips. Join strips to make bias binding.
- 1 Tree.
- From pink, purple, and green squares, cut a total of:
- 7 Trees. From yellow solid, cut:
- 8 Stars.

#### From brown solid, cut: • 8 Trunks.

#### **Quilt Assembly**

- Fold blue print background circle in half, then in half again. Lightly press folds to make placement lines for appliqué.
- 2. Referring to photo on page 19 and *Table Topper Diagram*, use creases as guides to arrange Trees, Trunks, and Stars atop circle. Fuse in place.

**3.** Machine appliqué using matching thread.



#### Finishing

- 1. Layer backing, batting, and table topper top; baste. Quilt as desired. Quilt shown was quilted with meandering in background (Quilting Diagram).
- **2.** Add binding to table topper.
